

Carbon Policy Statement

Lanseria International Airport (LIA) acknowledges the critical importance of addressing climate change and is dedicated to minimizing its carbon footprint. We are committed to operating sustainably and reducing our environmental impact through innovative practices and continuous improvement. Recognizing that climate change poses an existential threat to everyone, the aviation sector, like all other areas of the global economy, must achieve net-zero emissions by 2050.

The Carbon Policy is focused on the commitment management makes in ensuring that LIA complies with all relevant legislations regarding carbon emissions. This policy is applicable to every department within the airport, reinforcing our collective responsibility to safeguard the environment.

Policy Statement

- Lanseria International Airport (LIA) accepts the role of carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gases play in climate change. We also believe in the science behind climate change and have committed to reduce carbon emission by 10% for our Scope 1 and 2 emissions, managing our Scope 3 emissions and acting where we can assist our suppliers, customers and the wider economy reduce or eliminate fossil fuels.
- We support the global target, as established by the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) in the Paris Agreement 2015, to keep global temperature rise within 1.5 degrees, and we further support the updated 2030 emissions reduction target submitted to the UNFCCC in September 2021.
- LIA has voluntarily set a goal of improving carbon emissions by 10% the target being 2035 using FY18/19 as a baseline year. In FY2018/19, LIA's baseline scope 1 and scope 2 emissions were 5899 tCO₂e.

LIA is committed to fostering sustainability through a series of initiatives aimed at reducing its carbon footprint. A project to replace all remaining halogen light bulbs with energy-efficient LEDs and install motion sensors for lighting to enhance energy conservation is underway. We will also continue to explore innovative low-carbon and energy-saving technologies.
