Lanseria International Airport (LIA) acknowledges the critical importance of addressing climate change and is dedicated to minimizing its carbon footprint. We are committed to operating sustainability and reducing our environmental impact through innovative practices and continuous improvement. Recognising climate change poses an existential threat to everyone; the aviation sector, like all other areas of the global economy, must achieve net-zero emissions by 2050.

The carbon Policy is focused on the commitment management makes in ensuring that LIA complies with all relevant legislation regarding carbon emissions. This Policy is applicable to every department within airport, reinforcing our collective responsibility to safeguard the environment.

Policy Statement

- Lanseria International Airport (LIA) accepts the role that carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gases play in climate change. We support the science behind climate change and as such have committed to reducing our scope 1 and scope 2 emissions and managing our Scope 3 emissions through engagement with our suppliers, customers and other key stakeholders.
- We support the UNFCCC Paris Agreement 2015 target to keep global temperature rise within 1.5 degrees Celsius, and we further support the updated 2030 emissions reduction target submitted to the UNFCCC in September 2021.
- LIA has voluntarily set a target to achieve a 10% reduction in its combined scope 1 and 2 emissions by 2035 against FY18/19 baseline emissions of **5899 tCO₂e**.

LIA is committed to fostering sustainability through a series of initiatives aimed at reducing its carbon footprint. A project to replace all remaining halogen light bulbs with energy-efficient LEDs and install motion sensors for lighting to enhance energy conservation is underway. We will also continue to explore innovative low carbon and energy saving technologies.
